GAME FORMATS

Please Enter Players Names On The Card In Order Lowest Handicap "A" To Highest Handicap "D"

B/B MEDAL - SCORING - 90% Individual Fun Handicap - Par 73

Both players play all holes as per stroke play. The score for each hole is recorded as follows:-

The GROSS score for each player is recorded in the corresponding player's column "A" or "B"

The better NETT score for each hole is then recorded in the NETT score column.

Or just record the best NETT score in the NETT score column and the GROSS score for the corresponding player in the appropriate column - "A" or "B" (this makes adjudication much easier).

4 BALL - 2 + 2 STABLEFORD - 90% Fun Handicap - Par 72

The 4 man team is split into two teams of two Players A & B (div 1) & Players C & D (div 2)

Score for each hole is the sum of the best stableford score from each pair

Example - HOLE 1- A scores 3, B scores 3 / C scores 1, D scores 2 Score for hole 1 = A+D = 3+2 = 5

4 BALL YELLOW SPOT - STABLEFORD - 90% Fun Handicap - par 108

Player's names are entered on the card in order, lowest handicap "A" to highest handicap "D".

The "yellow spot" on HOLE 1 is player "A" - HOLE 2 player "B" - HOLE 3 player "C" - HOLE 4 player "D" etc.

Scoring for each hole is the sum of the yellow spot + 2 others

4 BALL LAS VEGAS - STABLEFORD - 90% Fun Handicap - par 396

The team score on each hole is a combination of the best 2 nett scores.

Example - player A scores 3 points and player C scores 4 points on hole 1, the score for hole 1 is 43

The final score is the sum of all 18 holes

AMERICAN FOURSOME - PAIRS STABLEFORD - 50% Combined Fun Handicap - par 36

- 1) Both players tee off as normal
- 2) Each player then plays his partners ball
- 3) One ball is then selected, the other ball is taken out of play
- 4) The next stroke played with the selected ball is played by the owner of that ball
- 5) Players then take alternate shots until the ball is holed out

A provisional ball may be played by the player who has just taken his stroke if he thinks the ball he has just played is lost outside a water hazard. If the original ball is then found the provisional ball is discarded.

Normal penalties apply i.e. stroke and distance.

Note:- penalty strokes are added to the score but do not count as the player's stroke.

(If in doubt, please note - players must not hit the same ball twice in a row).

4 BALL TRAFFIC LIGHTS (3 to Score) - par 108 - B/B TRAFFIC LIGHTS - par 108**STABLEFORD FORMAT**

Hole 1 - Tee off at designated tee (Yellow, Red or White)

Continue throughout the rest of the game following the coloured tees in order :-

(YELLOW START - Y/R/W) - (RED START - R/W/Y) - (WHITE START - W/Y/R)

4 BALL WALTZ (1-2-3) - STABLEFORD - 90% Fun Handicap - par 72

Hole 1 - the best score of the team is the team score - (1 to score)

Hole 2 - the two best scores are added for the team score - (2 to score)

Hole 3 - the three best scores are added for the team score - (3 to score)

Hole 4 - the rotation starts over and continues throughout the round.

4 BALL MULTIPLICATION - STABLEFORD - 90% Fun Handicap - par 72

The best two scores for each hole are multiplied together to determine the final score for each hole.

Example. "A" scores 2 points - "B" scores 3 points - "C" scores 0 points - "D" scores 0 points

Score for hole - A \times B = 2 \times 3 = 6 points. NB :- (n \times 0 = 0)

4 BALL PARS 123 - STABLEFORD - 90% Fun Handicap - par 70

1 score to count on par 5's / 2 on par 4's / 3 on par 3's.

Final score sum of scores for all 18 holes.

4 BALL 666-123 - STABLEFORD - 90% Fun Handicap - par 72

1 score to count on first 6 holes - 2 scores to count on second 6 holes and 3 scores to count on last 6 holes.

Final score sum of scores for all 18 holes.

RULES FOR SENIOR COMPETITIONS

- 1) The entrance fees are £2 competition and £1 for the 2's club.
- 2) Singles scores must be entered into the Club Computer at the conclusion of your round, even with a No Result.
- 3) The ball must be played through the green and penalty areas as per the R&A rules of golf.
Please report any infringement of the rules to a committee member.
- Please Note:- the Main Club and the Senior Section have not adopted the "drop another ball" rule when a ball is lost outside a water hazard or out of bounds. In both cases for speed of play please play a provisional ball or declare the original ball "unplayable lie" and play a substitute ball.*
- Improving the lie of your ball in any way is an infringement of the rules of golf. (bending, breaking or treading down foliage or pressing down behind the ball is not allowed.)*
- 4) Any ball that is to be lifted and replaced through the green or on the putting green must be marked and replaced as per the rules of golf.
- 5) The ball must finish in the hole as per the rules of golf. The ball is deemed as holed if it is at rest and the entire ball is below and remains below the putting surface. (13.2c). Failure to "hole out" in **medal** competitions will result in disqualification. **Stableford** - no score for that hole.
- 6) Please make out and mark your opponents score card and sign on completion of the round. If at all possible please use a pen / biro to mark your cards.
- 7) The player must also sign his own card.

PLAYERS, PLEASE CHECK YOUR INDEX & HANDICAP BEFORE PLAY.

PLEASE FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THE RULES OF GOLF AND PLAY FAIRLY WITH RESPECT FOR YOUR FELLOW COMPETITORS.

Senior Section Local Rule With Regard to R&A Rule (3.4b) Handicap Responsibility :-

For singles competitions, whether or not entered into the computer, no player will be disqualified for declaring an incorrect handicap on their scorecard.

For 'FUN' competitions failing to enter a handicap or declaring an incorrect handicap on the scorecard will result in the following :-

- 1) declaring a higher handicap - the player and team will be disqualified.
- 2) declaring a lower handicap - the score will stand uncorrected.
- 3) failing to declare a handicap - the player and team will be disqualified

Lost Ball:-

3 minutes is the maximum time allowed for a player to search for his ball. After 3 minutes has elapsed the ball is lost and another ball must be dropped and played within 1 club length of where the lost ball was last struck. (1 penalty stroke and distance).

If the original ball is found after 3 minutes and then played, this is defined as playing a wrong ball and the player must add a 2 stroke penalty to his score, and, to avoid disqualification, the player must still go back and play a substitute ball from within 1 club length of the place where the original ball was last struck, accumulating the 2 stroke penalty for playing a wrong ball as well as the 1 penalty stroke and distance. (strokes played with the wrong ball are not counted).

If, after playing a provisional ball, the original ball is found within the 3 minute search period the provisional ball **must** be abandoned. N.B. - You do not have the choice of playing the provisional ball.

Provisional or Substitute Ball:-

A player **must** declare when he is playing a provisional ball. If he deems that his first ball is in an "unplayable lie" he may substitute another ball, which then becomes the ball in play when it touches the ground. In this case the original ball **must** be abandoned.

Please note a ball cannot be declared "lost", the only circumstance when a ball in play is "lost" is, after searching for a period of 3 minutes, the ball is not found. A player wishing to abandon his ball must declare that he deems his ball is in an "unplayable lie" and that he is playing a substitute ball.

If you observe a member committing a rules infringement please inform them at the time of the infringement, and if necessary apply the correct penalty. In the case of a disagreement between players about a rule please inform a committee member who will try to address the problem.

When "Pick And Place" Is In Operation - The Rules Are:-

The ball may be lifted, cleaned and placed 6" from where the ball lay no nearer the hole.

Pick and place is only permitted on areas cut to fairway height or less i.e. If the ball is in the rough or in the first cut placing is not permitted. Breach of the rule carries a 2 stroke penalty if the ball is **not** replaced, or 1 stroke penalty if the ball is replaced. If the ball finishes in a divot or on a clump of grass in the rough or first cut pick and place is definitely not allowed.

Improving the lie of your ball in any way is an infringement of the rules of golf. (bending, breaking or treading down foliage or pressing down behind the ball is not allowed even when "pick and place" is in operation.

Ball Struck Into Trees Or Bushes - Unplayable Lie - Your Options Are As Follows:-

Play the ball as it lies or:-

- 1) drop the ball within 2 club lengths of where the ball lay no nearer the hole (1 stroke penalty).
- 2) drop the ball as far back as required keeping in line the point of relief, the place from where the relief is being taken and the flag (1 stroke penalty).
- 3) drop the ball within 1 club length of the spot from where the last shot was played (1 stroke penalty).

Relief From A Hole Made By A Burrowing Animal:-

Relief from a hole made by a burrowing animal is the nearest point of relief plus a club length no nearer the hole. The nearest point of relief not necessarily being the "best place for me" but the nearest relief from the hole. It should be noted that animal droppings are treated as loose impediments and moving the ball in this situation is a rule infringement and carries a 2 stroke penalty if the ball is not replaced, 1 stroke if the ball is replaced, before making a stroke.

NB If it is not possible to make a fair and reasonable stroke at a ball due to trees or bushes or the like then in that situation taking free relief from a hole made by a burrowing animal is **not** allowed and relief under unplayable lie must be used.(Rule 19 - 1 stroke penalty).

Playing From Outside The Designated Teeing Ground Or Wrong Tee:-

Teeing from the wrong tee or from outside the designated teeing area carries a 2 stroke penalty and the ball must be re-played from within the teeing ground.

NB in **medal** play if the error is not corrected before completion of the hole the penalty is disqualification.

In **stableford** competitions if the error is not corrected before completion of the hole the player is disqualified from that hole.
